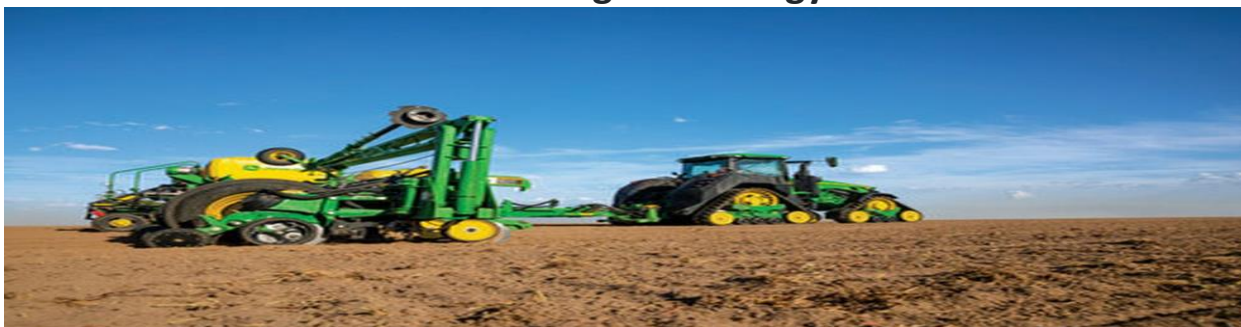
SECURITY

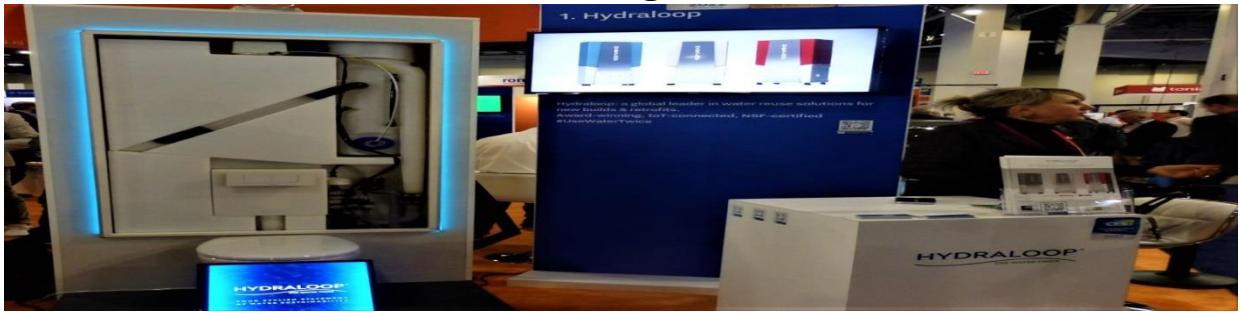


John Deere Debuts New Planting Technology & Electric Excavator



The legendary “John Deere company” pulled up the curtain on **John Deere’s ExactShot**. It uses a sensor to register when each individual seed is in the process of going into the soil. A robot will spray only the amount of fertilizer needed directly onto the seed at the exact moment as it goes into the ground. This process could save over 93 million gallons of starter fertilizer annually. Powered by Kreisel batteries, Deere's new **electric excavators** will improve reliability, performance and safety in construction.

For the Drought



The **Hydraloop**: With this system in place, water is collected from washing machines, bathtubs and showers. The water is cleaned and disinfected so it can be reused. The **Hydraloop H300** cleans up to 140 gallons of water per day and the **Hydraloop H600** cleans about 260 gallons of water per day for homes and small businesses. The systems are not large or overly complicated, and any skilled plumber can install one. Once the system is in place, water will start being recycled immediately. Very Important: The treated graywater is non-potable, so one should not directly drink or cook with it.

Wellbeing



The **German Bionic Cray X** powered exoskeleton helps to protect the health and wellbeing of those involved in manual handling tasks at the workplace. The Cray X power suit provides up to 66 pounds of support per lifting movement. The suit received a CES® 2023 Innovation Award as “Best of Innovation”.

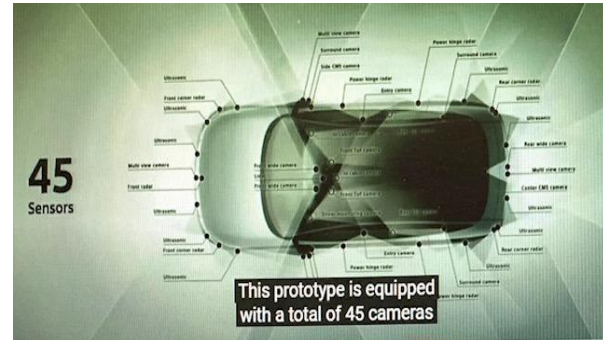

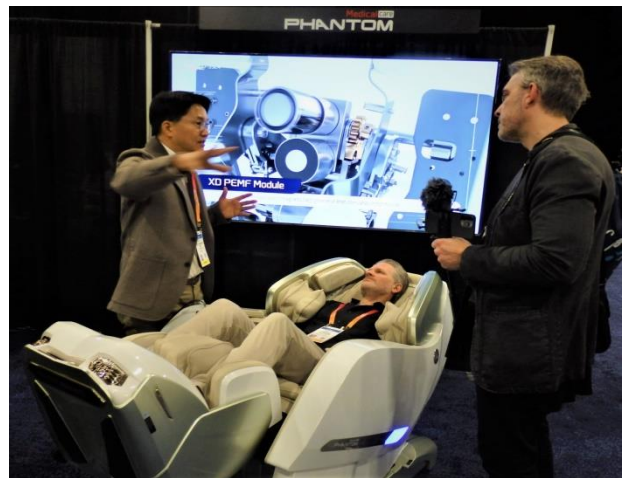
SAVINGS

The **Squad** is a two-passenger car with a small solar panel on its roof that offers up to 19.2 miles on a sunny day. The golf cart-style vehicle can travel up to 60 miles on a single full charge. The powertrain consists of two 2-kilowatt rear in-wheel motors powered by four 1.6kWh batteries that are swappable. It has a top speed of just under 30 mph. The car has four-wheel disc brakes, seat belts and a roll cage for safety. It may not be the sportiest car on the block, but it saves you money.
